

Suggested wording to include in your Will

Leaving a bequest to World Animal Protection is one of the most important decisions you'll ever make, because it's a lasting statement about the way you feel about animals. More than that, it ensures we can act on your behalf to free animals from cruelty – and make their world a better, safer place.

Residuary bequest

Once you've provided for your loved ones, you can leave the remainder of your estate to World Animal Protection.

"I give and bequeath to World Animal Protection Limited ABN 19083297027 of GPO Box 3294, Sydney NSW 2000, for general purposes, the residue of my estate, free of all duties, and I declare the receipt of the Treasurer or other proper officer for the time being of World Animal Protection Australia shall constitute an absolute discharge to my Trustee."

Pecuniary bequest

This is when you make a gift of a specific sum of money to World Animal Protection.

"I give and bequeath to World Animal Protection Limited ABN 19083297027 GPO Box 3294, Sydney NSW 2000, for general purposes, the sum of (insert amount), free of all duties, and I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or other proper officer for the time being of World Animal Protection Australia shall constitute an absolute discharge to my Trustee."

If you are leaving a home or item in your Will

Alternatively, you may wish to leave a very specific item to World Animal Protection, such as a house, or other personal effect.

"I give, devise and bequeath to World Animal Protection Limited ABN 19083297027 of GPO Box 3294, Sydney NSW 2000, for general purposes, all my share and interest in the property known as (insert full address or exact details of item) at my death, free of all duties, and I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or other proper officer for the time being of World Animal Protection Australia shall constitute an absolute to my Trustee."
